Choose your homework from the menu below:

The Peri-ometer suggests the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer.

- You should hand in one piece of work every week (by Friday)
- Every term you should attempt at least one 'EXTRA HOT' task, you can have 2 weeks for this!



Find an Egyptian recipe (ancient or modern). Create this recipe and take a photo to show your creation. (Write the recipe to go with your photo in case others would like to have a go.)

Can you make a game or activity which needs an electrical circuit? Use the internet to help you with ideas. You could include a switch in your design.

Create your own tomb or coffin for a mummy. Remember they are decorated with a picture of the person and show off their wealth.

Where does electricity come from? Carry out some research and present your information as a fact-file or poster.

Write a description of entering a tomb for the first time. (It was dark as we entered, with only a chink of light from the opening we had made. The air was stuffy and closed in all around us...)

Write a diary entry from the viewpoint of an Egyptian. They could be a Pharaoh or a poor person in Egyptian times.

Create a poster advertising an Egyptian museum collection. Think about how you could persuade people to want to visit the museum.

Make a simple game about Ancient Egypt e.g. snap, snakes and ladders etc

Draw and label an electrical circuit. Can you draw one that you know will work and one that won't and explain how you know?

Create an Ancient Egyptian quiz. You will need at least 5 interesting questions that you could ask the class.

Design a poster to highlight the potential dangers of electrical appliances at home/school.

Create a word search or crossword about Ancient Egypt. This can be about one specific topic or Ancient Egypt in general.
