

Literacy

Non-fiction : We will be researching Dinosaurs and other animals, writing newspaper reports and factfiles about them and recipes for them.

Poetry: Dinosaur/animal poems.

Music

We will be describing sounds that dinosaurs and other animals might make or hear. We'll choose instruments to recreate some of these sounds.

We will use a variety of instruments to experiment with beat, rhythm and tempo.

Art / DT

Exploring Materials: We will use different materials to create dinosaur/animal images. We will use a range of media including pastels, charcoal, paint, print and collage.

ICT

Use internet texts to gather information for reports.

Use ICT as a way of producing dinosaur/animal art work and factfiles

Create our own animals using ICT

Maths

We will be revising previous skills and: recognising odd and even numbers; counting objects in 5s and 10s and beginning to say 5 lots and 10 lots; finding simple fractions of shapes; learning number bonds and related subtraction facts; using knowledge of pairs of 10 to make pairs to 20; using number facts to solve word problems; reading/writing times to the hour; measuring using uniform units; adding a 1-digit number by counting on from a 2-digit number, beginning to cross 10s; subtracting a 1-digit number by counting back and from multiples of 10.

Science
