Choose your homework from the menu below:

The Peri-ometer suggests the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer.

- You should hand in one piece of work every week (by Friday)
- Every term you should attempt at least one 'EXTRA HOT' task, you can have 2 weeks for this
- You may choose the same task twice as long as it is on a different topic



Create a model or artefact linked to one of our topics and write an explanation to go with it e.g. what it is or how it was used. You may be asked to share this with the class.

Write a news article or record a news report about something we have been learning about in class. Have a look at newspapers for an idea of how they are presented and research your topic.

Write an imagined discussion between a child who is struggling to understand one of our topics and a child who is helping them.

Create a crossword with keywords from one of our topics. Write a definition of each keyword as a clue. Have a look at crosswords to see how they work.

Create a leaflet or factsheet summarising a topic that we have been learning about. You should also add additional research and facts.

Research an important person that we have not discussed in class. The person must be linked to one of our topics. Bring in your findings.

Write a poem or song that summarises a topic that we have been learning about.

Create 10 challenging quiz questions about one of our topics. Make sure you also include the correct answers.

Create a mind map about a topic that we have been learning about. Include keywords, pictures and questions.

Create a poster summarising what we have learnt recently in one of our lessons.

Create a wordsearch with key words from one of our topics. You must also explain what some of the words mean.

Draw and label a picture linked to one of our topics.
