Create some space, alien, witch/wizard or invention themed Top Trumps cards.	Create an information sheet about space, aliens or witches/wizards. You could include diagrams/pictures/facts.	Research an important person linked to our topics. Bring in your findings.
Write a poem or song about an aspect of this topic that we have been learning about.	Write 5 quiz questions about the topic. Make sure you also include the correct answers.	Write a character description for a character from space or an inventor. Draw a picture to go with it.
