Create a mini-project on a UK city that contrasts with where we live e.g. Manchester, Sheffield, Birmingham (please do not do your project about Cardiff).

Make a model of a UK landmark. Find out information about the landmark - when / why was it built? Who built it? Why is it famous? Where is the landmark located?

What can you find out about changes in temperature in the UK? How has the temperature changed over time? How do locations in the UK vary in temperature? Can you present your findings on a graph with an explanation?

Create a tourism advert for a location in the UK. Why should people visit this location? What is there? What can people do there?

Research a holy journey made by believers of any religion. Where do they go? Why? What happens there? Include as much information as you can.

What happens to materials when they are heated/cooled? Produce an explanation using scientific vocabulary and give examples to help you explain.

Produce a poster which explains the stages of the water cycle.

Write a telephone conversation between Peter and the Ancient Child (from 'How to Live Forever'). What would they want to say to each other?

Would you like to live forever? Write a paragraph or two explaining your choice. Try to make your writing imaginative and descriptive!

Draw a map of the UK. Can you label key cities and landmarks on your map?

Create a quiz or word search linked to counties of the UK.

Describe the properties of a solid, liquid or gas. You can draw pictures to help and use examples of each.
