- Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material

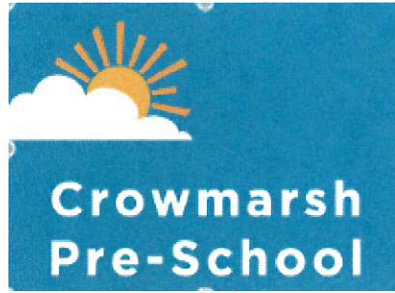
If you fill the donation bag and still have more then you can use any other bag to donate your items and don't forget to ask grandparents, friends and neighbours to have a sort out as well!

Developing the outdoor area

Forest School

Forest School will begin again in Monday 20th January. This will run every Monday morning and we aim to use the site as much as possible throughout the winter. Please ensure your child wears suitable clothing on the day – this includes boots, hats and scarves and waterproof gloves if they have them. We do have a supply of warm waterproof coats and trousers but would be very grateful if your child could bring in their own if they have them as we do not have enough for every child. If you would like your child to come along on a day that they do not attend, please feel free to join us. Please note, you would need to stay with your child in this situation.

Snow days

Please be aware that in the event of snow, it is sometimes necessary to close Pre – School. You will be informed of the closure by email at the earliest possible opportunity. An announcement will also be posted on the Parents FaceBook page. You can also check the Crowmarsh Gifford School website and listen to local radio stations for announcements about school closures. If the school closes, we will always close too. This decision is never taken lightly. Although most of our families live within walking distance of Pre-School, the majority of staff do not, and we have to ensure the safety of all.

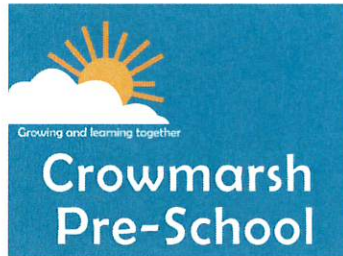

As you will have just been informed, I will be visiting Crowmarsh School to run poetry assemblies and workshops on Friday 7th February 2020.

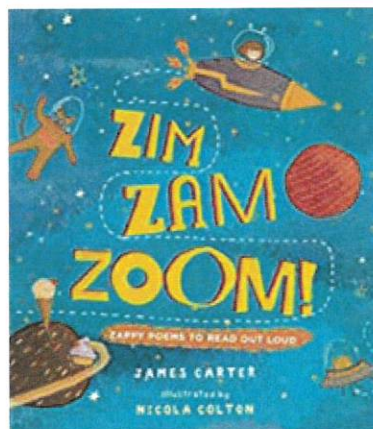
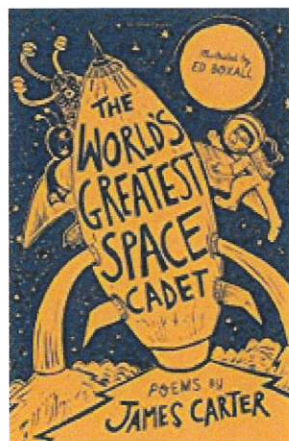
