

Class R Learning Menu

Please use with children in self isolation. Choose a challenge a day. You can repeat challenges, try them in a different way.



Share a book Talk about the pictures. Tell your own story from the pictures. Then read the text. Are there any words/letter that you recognise? S, a, t, p, l, n, m, d?	Create your own number line Use resources from around your house. This could be pasta/ Lego/Cars. Create a number line using the correct number of objects to represent each number. Your adult could write the numeral for you. What number can you get to?	Sort small items Pick up small items between the thumb and first finger sort them so that all the objects that are similar are together.
Play a game Find a game you enjoy playing (snap, pairs, lotto, dominoes)	Do some baking/ cooking. You could bake something really or imaginary, inside or outside, the possibilities are endless!	Create a picture of yourself Use crayons, felt tips, paint, collage to create a picture of yourself. Look closely in a mirror to get the right colours and shapes.
Draw a picture of your family. Can you label it? What letter does the name start with? Who else is in your family?	Photograph some of your favourite food! Photograph and get your adult to scribe what they taste like/ why you like them. Try a new food and describe the taste.	Build a model Build a model of what you enjoy doing the most. This could be you on your bike, with your dog, swimming or seeing your friends.
Collect and/or explore objects that interest you. What interesting objects can you find in your garden/ around your house? Ask questions about what they are and maybe what they are used for?	Play I spy Use colours/description. i.e. something red/ something stripy. I went to the shops and I bought ...	All about my family. Talk about whether your siblings are older/ younger. Learn when your birthday is, what your address is. You could make a family tree!
